PROPOSED LEGISLATION – 2023

AMENDMENT OF TITLE 22. SUBTITLE 10 LICENSES FOR SPECIFIC TYPES OF ORGANIZATIONS AND VENUES

Purpose: This legislation is intended to amend the AB Article to permit an art establishment to sell beer and wine under certain conditions.

TITLE 22. HARFORD COUNTY

SUBTITLE 10. LICENSES FOR SPECIFIC TYPES OF BUSINESSES (ORGANIZATIONS) AND VENUES

§ 22-1009 Art and Entertainment License

(a) Established

There is a Class AE (art and entertainment) license.

(b) Authorized holder

(1) The Board may issue the license for use to an organization engaged in:

(i) “Art” herein defined as a diverse display, sale, instruction in creating art, or demonstration of art by an individual artist or a group of artists except those prohibited under AB §4-605 and Board rule 4:23;

(ii) entertainment that includes instruction, demonstration, and participation by clients in the form of entertainment.

(2) The Board may not issue the license to an organization that displays and sells commercially prepared or mass-produced artistic products.

(c) Scope of authorization

(1) The license authorizes the holder to sell or serve beer and wine at retail for on-premises consumption.

(2) The issuance of a license is at the discretion of the Board.

Hours and days of sale

(e) The license holder may sell or serve beer and wine:

(1) on Monday through Sunday, from 8 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day.

Transfer of license prohibited

(f) The license may not be transferred to another location.

Alcohol awareness training requirements

(g) A business for which the license is issued is subject to the alcohol awareness training requirements under § 4-505 of this article.

Purchase

(h) Beer and wine must be purchased from a retailer or from a licensed manufacturer or wholesaler.

(i) Prepackaged snacks are required to be available for purchase at all times when alcoholic beverages may be sold.

(j) An establishment for which the license is issued is subject to all requirements of the Alcoholic Beverages Article and the Rules and Regulations of the Harford County Liquor Control Board.

Fee

(j) The annual license fee is \$850.
