1) First-Time Applicants – HDG Arts Collective / Arts by the Bay – 11/21 B&W

First-time applicants Tina Bianca and Angelo Bianca appeared on behalf of HDG Arts Collective / Arts by the Bay in connection with a per diem application for beer and wine for an artist's reception being held on 11/21 at the Arts by the Bay Gallery in Havre de Grace. ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS

1) Fines Paid

The following fines imposed by the Board have been paid: Burgology of Bel Air, L.L.C. T/A Sol Oaxaca \$350 (AA and Failure to Appear) and TCL Properties, L.L.C. T/A Wine World Beer & Spirits \$500 (Sale to Underage). Abbey Burger has not paid the \$6000 in fines imposed by the Board; GM Crabbs left a message for their attorney Stephan Fogleman yesterday but has not yet heard back. Mr. Crabbs will advise Mr. Fogleman that his clients have until noon on Friday, November 7, to pay the fine.

2) KG Abingdon Liquors, Inc. T/A KG Abingdon Liquors – 60 Day Status Update

The Board issued tentative approval for this change in location on August 13 and a 60-day status update indicates that work has begun on the tenant fit out but there is no completion date.

3) October's Performance Budget

The three-month CD is up for renewal, however, those funds will need to be deposited in the general operating account. The 13-month CD that renews in April can be rolled.

4) Fallston Barrel House

Carolyn Evans and Anthony DiPaula have not responded to Ms. Finneran's messages concerning the appeal on behalf of Fallston Barrel House.
